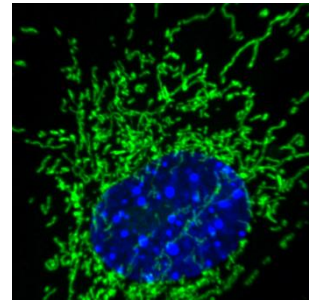


Master student position available

A Master student position is available in the Laboratory of RNA Biology and Functional Genomics, Institute of Biochemistry and Biophysics of Polish Academy of Sciences in Warsaw.

We are looking for a highly motivated candidate who would like to join a mitochondrial research group working under the supervision of dr. Roman Szczesny.

In collaboration with a few other teams we have recently found that the transcription of the mitochondrial genome is a major source of dsRNA in humans (*Dhir, Borowski... Szczesny & Proudfoot, Nature, 2018*). We discovered that dsRNA can be released from mitochondria, which results in activation of the innate immune system and can contribute to human disease. To identify proteins involved in mt-dsRNA metabolism we conducted a genome-wide siRNA screen, where the level of mt-dsRNA was measured by high-throughput fluorescent microscopy. This resulted in the identification of several putative factors related to mt-dsRNA, including known mtRNA players as well as proteins whose link to mtRNA metabolism was unexpected. These proteins will be subjected to functional studies during the project. Our long term goal is to understand the molecular mechanisms of dsRNA metabolism in human mitochondria and explore potential links between mt-dsRNA and human diseases. The project is carried out within the FIRST TEAM programme of the Foundation for Polish Science.

Profile of candidate/requirements:

1. The successful candidate must have the status of a 2nd degree student or a student of an equivalent programme at a Polish unit (biology, biotechnology or other related life science discipline)
2. Passion for science, creativity. Outstanding university records. Ability to work independently as well as in a team.
3. Ability to analyze data and draw conclusions. Good communication and organization skills.
4. At least 1 month of experience in experimental research.
5. Interest in various life science disciplines would be an advantage.

Required documents:

1. CV including scientific achievements, short description of research project conducted so far (if applicable), list of known/used methods by the applicant, results of high school final exams (indicate basic/advanced level), participation in any competition in high school, any other relevant information (prizes, honors, IT skills)
2. Optional documents: reference letter, motivation letter – why do you study biology, what has been your favorite academic course (why?), what are your future plans, are you going to continue your scientific career? (maximum 1 page, Calibri, 12 pts)
